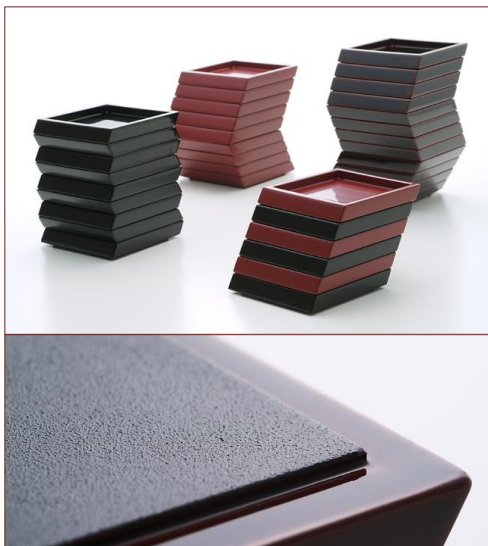




Wood plates that stack at an angle of 25° are available in two different sizes and are suitable for hors d'oeuvres at special parties or displaying jewelry on your dresser. How you stack them is entirely up to you. A large plate holds 4 smaller plates and can be stacked with them in it. Finished with the hand-painted finest Echizen Urushi lacquer and comes in vermilion, ebony and "Tame". Wash with warm water and wipe quickly with soft cloth. Avoid direct sunlight, extreme humidity and dryness. Smaller plates of fine porcelain are also available. They come with Edo Komon patterns or in simple pale. Urethane lacquered wood plates in white, black, vermilion and siskin green are offered to accommodate porcelain plates.
