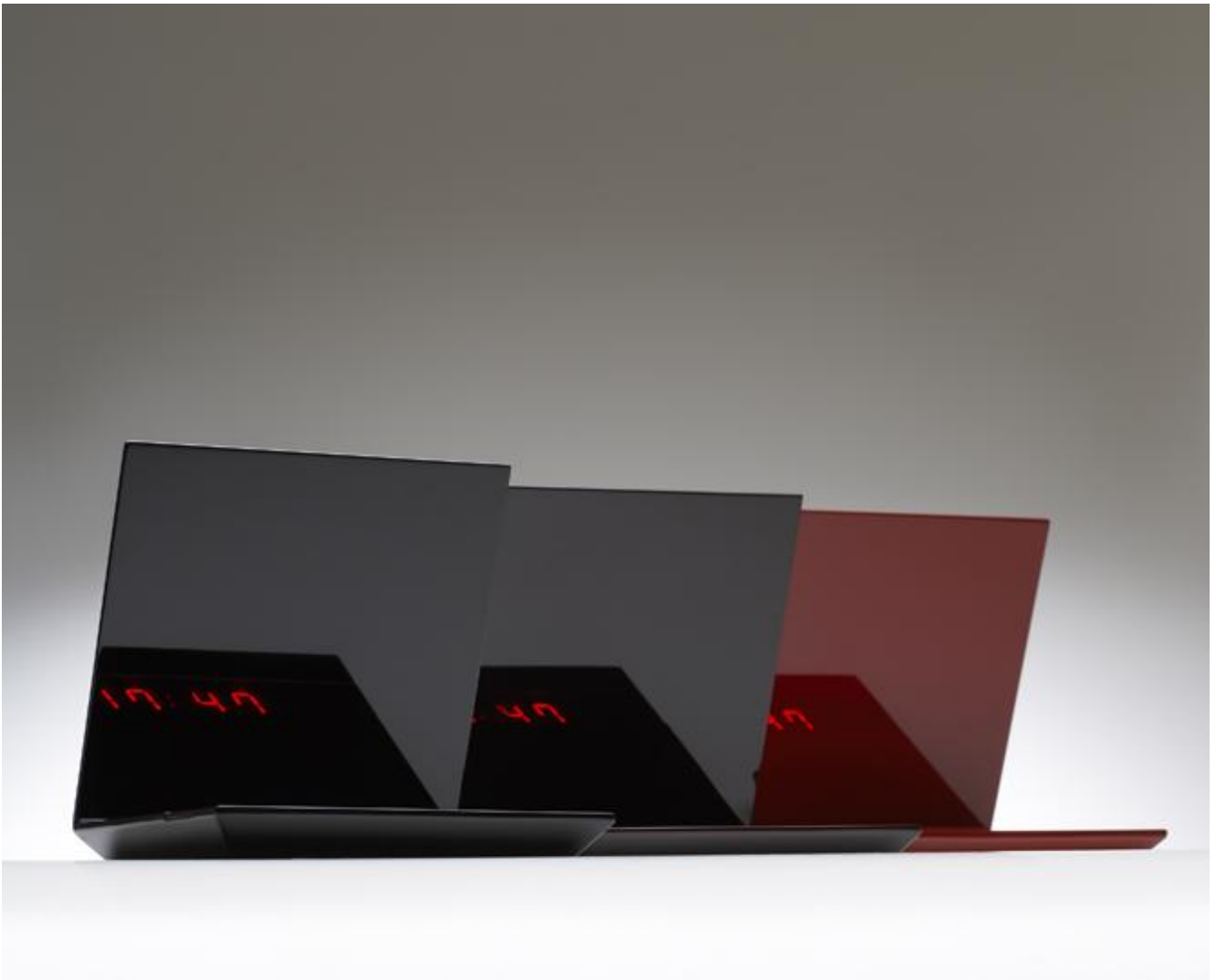

The time indicated is actually the reversed reflection of the digital clock placed on the bottom. Finest Kiso lacquer finish comes in vivid vermilion, ebony and "Tame". Tame is the name of a method of a special technique. Vermilion lacquer is painted on the lower layer and translucent lacquer on the upper layer. The degree of transparency gets higher as time goes by and the vermilion layer gradually appears. Gently wet the surface with warm cloth and wipe it with soft dry cloth. Avoid direct sunlight, extreme humidity and dryness. Made of steel and equipped with an alarm.
